## 4 hex removal spells

### Hoodoo Flying Devil

This spell not only removes the hex, it actually returns the same hex to the sender. Collect the following items for this powerful spell:

Black pepper  
Cinnamon  
Vetiver  
Dragon's blood resin  
Patchouli

Thoroughly grind all the above items to a fine powder while visualizing the hex disappearing. Burn it on hot charcoals while murmuring your desires into it. Repeat the grinding and burning for seven consecutive days.

### Evil eye removal spell

For this spell, get a handful of uzarlik (Syrian Rue, harmel). If you don't have it, get some spices and herbs from the kitchen. Also get some sea salt

Hold this in your hand and circle it around the target's head making three complete rotations while chanting:

You are Air  
You are against my every grief  
Pluck out the evil eye  
Evil eye away!

Throw the herbs into a fire. Popping and spluttering noises mean that the demons are being scared away never to return.

### Doll Hex Removal





Make a doll to represent you by gathering some old cotton clothes and cutting them to size. Write your name on a piece of paper and pin it to the doll. If you are trying to remove the hex from someone else, pin their name to it.

Now get some Four Thieves Vinegar and mix it with equal amount of spring water. Soak the doll in this solution and leave it overnight exposed to moonlight. Murmur your desires to the doll and charge it with its mission.

At night, take the doll to the crossroads and leave it in the bushes where no one will find it. Return home via a complex route.

#### Dragon Hex Remover

For this spell, get some dragon's blood resin or powder. Burn it near an open window at midnight for seven consecutive nights. The hex will be completely removed by the eighth day.
